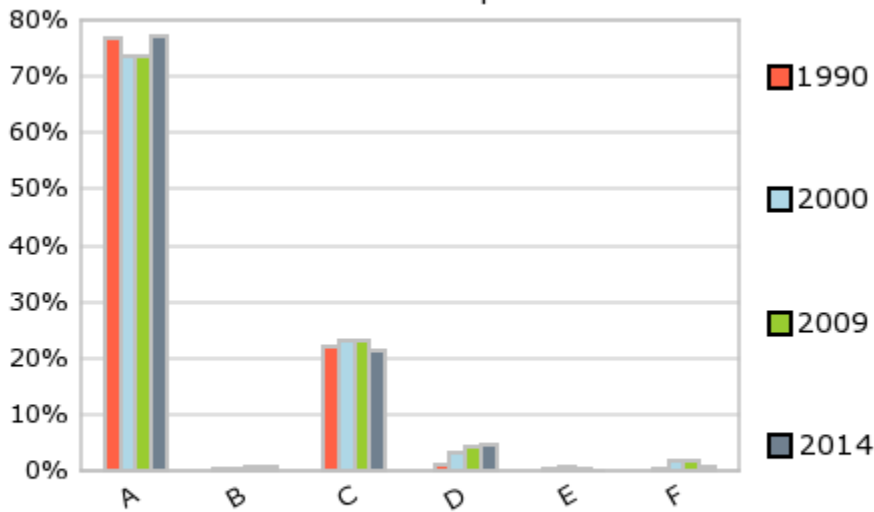

F: Other or Multi Race

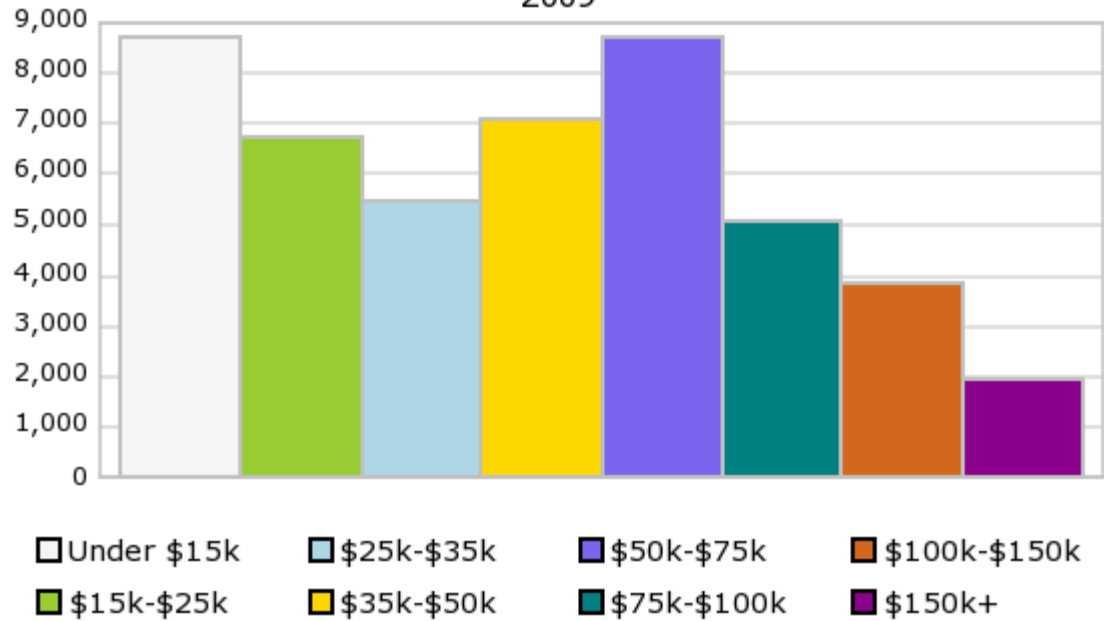
